Set up your device as a personal hotspot and share your data connection with up to 10 Wi-Fi-capable devices concurrently.

To turn on and activate your mobile hotspot:

1. Open the Menu
2. Select the Settings gear icon (fig. A)
3. Select 'Network & Internet' (fig. B)
4. Select 'Hotspot & tethering' (fig. C)
5. Select Portable Wi-Fi hotspot (fig. D)
6. Your mobile hotspot is now enabled! Enter your network name, select "security" from the drop-down list and create a password of at least 8 characters (fig. E, F, G)

From the "Hotspot & Tethering screen, you may also adjust your hotspot settings, view connected devices, turn off your mobile hotspot, and/or share your mobile connection via USB and Bluetooth.

For USB tethering:

- Follow steps 1-4 from Wi-Fi hotspot instructions.
- Enable USB tethering. This is only available when USB is connected to device.

For Bluetooth tethering:

- Follow steps 1-4 from Wi-Fi hotspot instructions.
- Enable Bluetooth tethering to share your phone's internet connection with other Bluetooth paired devices.

If your XP5s is turned off at any point, you will need to reactivate your mobile hotspot once it has turned back on.

Unless you have enabled "Keep WiFi Hotspot on" from the "Hotspot & Tethering" menu, your mobile hotspot will turn off when the device is idle for 10 minutes.

Utilizing your XP5s as a hotspot requires an eligible data plan. You can monitor your data usage and adjust data usage settings by selecting Menu > Settings > Network & Internet > Data Usage. Contact your service provider with questions regarding your plan.
